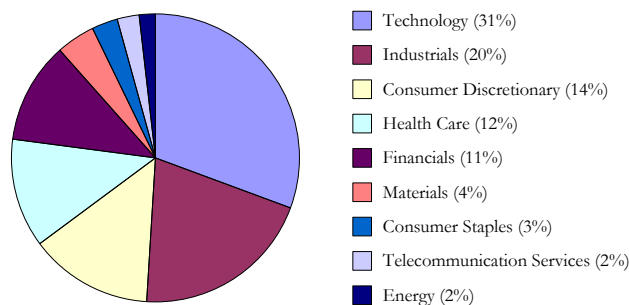


Global IPO Fund

Fund Description

The **Global IPO Fund** is an actively managed mutual fund that invests in a portfolio of newly public companies at the time of the offering and in post-IPO trading. The Global IPO Fund's portfolio management team seeks to outperform the broader equity market by utilizing Renaissance Capital's industry-recognized research to assist in the decision making process. In addition to post-IPO investing, the Global IPO Fund's experienced portfolio management team has the ability to purchase IPOs on the offering.
